

The Levy


- Budget is a continual balancing act. 2017 at over \$10m against projected levy income of \$8.1m
- Further projects recently approved
- Half way to next referendum
- FFA and SME representation has had specific attention

Total Expenditure breakdown (2016 Actual)




Strategic Objective

Improve the profitability of growing forests on a sustainable basis:

- Protect forest assets and markets from adverse factors
- Improve productivity and fibre uniformity
- Sustain and enhance forestry's license to operate
- Improve efficiency and safety in operations
- Species for diversity of sites and markets

GCFF Observations

- Single biggest levy investment - \$1.6m per year
- Gold rating by MBIE very significant achievement
- High level of industry engagement
- Increased FGLT funding - \$ 0.90m in 2017
- Findings are being implemented – but need to increase
- Challenge is small grower uptake
